Research Facility

The 5,000 square foot research facility is staffed with full and part-time clinical research professionals. The research professionals includes two Board Certified Physicians, Certified Family Nurse Practitioners, registered nurses and Bachelor/Masters level employees with expertise in conducting and facilitating clinical research studies. HRHR operates according to written SOPs and provides in-house training to all employees.
